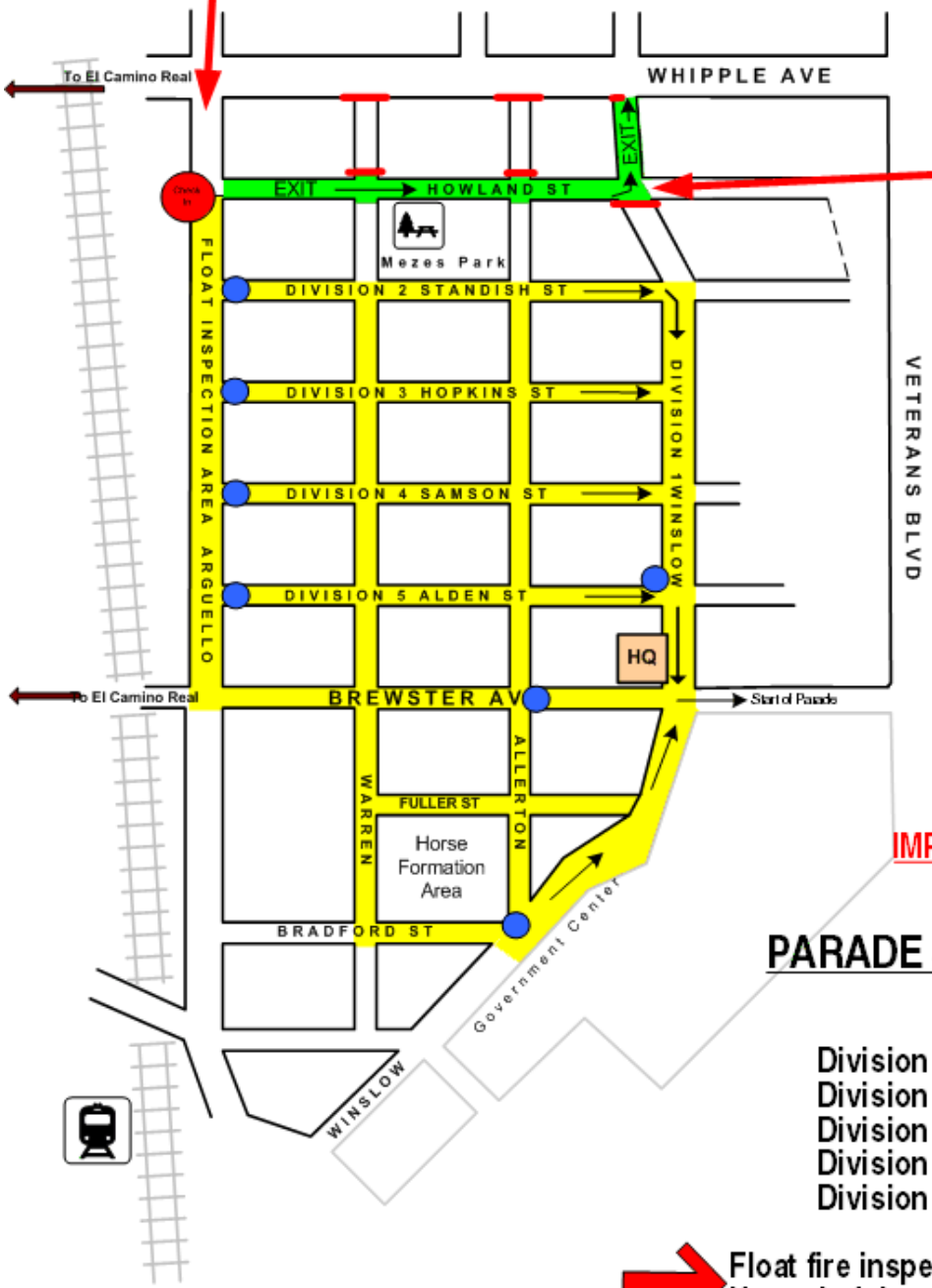

LINE-UP - ENTRANCE FOR ALL ENTRIES is at Whipple & Arguello. When you arrive, check in with the entry check-in tent at Howland and Arguello who will direct you to the division Marshal's table located at your street and Arguello. Floats check in at Howland and Arguello. We value the relationship we have with the community. We ask that you please be considerate of our neighbors when you are setting up on the 4th. We are using their streets to lineup the parade. Please keep noise to a minimum and please pickup your garbage.

ALL UNITS - This is a ***Forward Motion Parade*** and you will be judged throughout the Parade route. Continuous ***Forward Motion*** will be required at all times. We ask your full cooperation in keeping the Parade in a constant ***Forward Motion*** from beginning to end. Please maintain approximately 100 feet behind the unit in front of you unless you are otherwise instructed.

DISQUALIFICATION - In the interest of maintaining a smooth running parade, subject to the discretion of Parade Officials, we reserve the right to ***Disqualify and Remove*** from the Parade any unit that causes undue delay, does not meet participant requirements or has not been previously approved by Parade Entries Committee.

FLOATS - Floats will be inspected by the Fire Department. They will assemble at the formation area on Arguello. Floats are to be in their area completely ready for inspection no later than 8:30 a.m. The float will enter into the line-of-march with your other entries. Float Awards will be based on judging and performance during the Parade. ***All floats and all tow vehicles must each carry fire extinguishers (minimum 2A-10BC).*** If it is visible, points are not deducted.

EQUESTRIAN UNITS - NOTICE: Please check the enclosed map for the Equestrian unloading area. **Units arriving late will be judged under a five (5) point penalty.** Please clean up your own horse manure. Thank you for your cooperation. Please display pass in windshield of vehicle. If you get blocked in by another vehicle, please contact a parade official. We will have vehicle removed.

JUDGING-Equestrian Units will be judged by Larry Durbin of Independent Equestrian Parade Judges. Judging for other units is done by members of the Pacific Coast Judges Association.

PARADE END - All units will continue on line of march on to the end of the Parade Sign at Arguello and Alden and follow instructions of Parade Officials.
